GRADUATE STUDENT TRAVEL AWARD:

In order to encourage graduate students to engage in the activities of the Western Branch, the society has created the "Graduate Student Travel Award of the American Oriental Society, Western Branch." This year, two awards will be offered to subvent expenses to attend the Western Branch meeting up to a sum of \$500. Awardees will also be honored by special recognition during the conference and on the society's website. The number of awards in future years will depend on the amount of donations made for this purpose.

Graduate students who intend to apply for the award should indicate this in the e-mail message that accompanies the submission of their registration form and abstract. All applications to the Graduate Student Award will be anonymously reviewed by members of the Executive Committee of the Western Branch.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Arrangements have been made with the **University Place Hotel** (ph: 1-866-845-4647; 503-221-0140; fax: 503-224-0744; email: uplace@pdx.edu) for a special conference rate of \$97/night for either a double or King sized single "comfort" room (plus 16% city tax). The hotel provides complimentary breakfast. Please mention that you are coming for the American Oriental Society Western Branch meeting in order to obtain the conference rate. The special rate will be available until **September 12th**, after which reservations will be on a space and rate availability basis only.

TRAVEL:

Out-of-town participants can fly to Portland International Airport (PDX). The hotel is easily reached by taking the MAX light rail from the airport. As you exit the concourse take the stairs down to the baggage claim level and turn right. Follow the signs for MAX light rail to the Southwest corner of the terminal. Tickets can be purchased from machines just inside the door of the terminal or on the train platform immediately outside the doors. The cost is \$2.50 for a ticket good on all public transportation for two and one half hours.

Instructions for Most Convenient Route to the Hotel Using Public Transportation: Take the MAX (Red Line) from the airport to Downtown Portland. Exit at the Pioneer Square stop, backtrack one block and turn left across the street to transfer to the southbound Orange Line to Milwaukie. Get off at the SW 3rd and Lincoln stop. The hotel is on the south side of the street right across from the light rail stop. Trip planner: https://trimet.org

There are also numerous shuttle, Uber and taxi services from the airport at a cost of approx. \$50+. If you are driving, overnight parking at the hotel is available for \$13 per day. Portland weather is often nice but a bit unpredictable in October as it is the transition period between the warm and dry summer months to the cool and rainy late autumn and winter.
